Interschool Sports Day

This year Interschool Sports Day is at Yorketown Area School on **Thursday 30th March**. Attached to this newsletter is a copy of the days program. The events your children will be participating in are highlighted. All students are asked to be at Yorketown and report in to Miss Hoskins **by 8:50am**. As you will see by the program all younger students running events are over by approximately 11:00am. As long as parents are there with the students the younger students may leave with the parents for the remainder of the day.

PLEASE NOTE SCHOOL WILL BE CLOSED FOR THE DAY. ALL STUDENTS WILL BE EXPECTED TO ATTEND SPORTS DAY EVEN IF THEY ARE NOT COMPETING – unless prior arrangements have been made with Miss Hoskins.



What will my child need for the day:

- Packed recess, lunch and fruit
- School Hat
- Plenty of water for the whole day
- Spare t-shirt to be changed into at the end of the day
- Money (should you choose) There will be limited snacks available
- Sunscreen

As with out small schools sports day, all students will be sent home with a sports day top to be worn on Thursday. At the conclusion of the day we will take the t-shirts back and the children will need another top to put on afterwards.

Please make sure all children come to sports day with sunscreen applied. Then please put the sunscreen in the children's bags so we can re-apply later in the day.

We are asked as school staff to help Yorketown with the running of events. This means staff are very busy on the day so any parent help to make sure the children all get to their events on time and are behaving themselves in the school area would be gratefully appreciated.

As stated earlier – once children's events have finished, you are free to take your children home. However please do not leave without letting Miss Hoskins know you are going. All students need to be marked off the roll before they go home.
